BOARDING POLICY

The Eastern Shores School Board may assist those persons needing boarding homes in communities where a residence is not available by providing them with the names of suitable boarding homes. It is the responsibility of the person requiring lodging to contact the boarding home and make the necessary arrangements.

Parents of students under the jurisdiction of the Eastern Shores School Board, or adult students themselves, must advise the School Board of the name and address of the school which the said student is attending, as well as the the name, address, and telephone number of the boarding home.

It is the responsibility of the boarding parent or the adult boarder to have the room and board attestation form completed and returned to the Eastern Shores School Board not later than the 25th of each month in order to receive payment.

It is also the responsibility of the boarding parent or adult boarder to immediately notify the Educational Services Department at 752-2247, ext. 224, of any change regarding the student's residence.

Boarding Allowance

Students boarding in private homes will be granted a monthly allowance of \$225 for each month they are in school (\$450 in the case of Entry Island students who choose to complete their secondary studies in a school under the jurisdiction of the Eastern Shores School Board). Parents or adult boarders will be required to pay the difference between the amount subsidized and the actual cost.
