

NOTICE TO ELECTORS

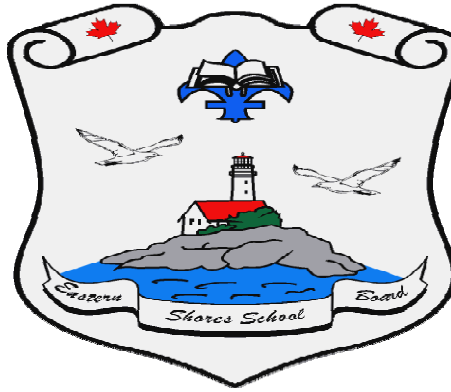
The Eastern Shores School Board wishes to inform its citizens that the elections called for November 4, 2007 will not take place as all commissioners were elected by acclamation, and we will not be revising the electoral list.

However, if you would like to have your name added on the Anglophone list and you meet the following criteria, please complete the Declaration of Choice on the right side of this flyer.

Every person who on polling day:

- has obtained 18 years of age,
- is a Canadian citizen,
- is domiciled in the territory of the school board and has been domiciled in Quebec for at least six (6) months,
- is not under curatorship, and
- has not been convicted within the last five years of an offence that is corrupt electoral or referendum practice under this Act, the referendum Act (chapter C-64.1), the Act respecting elections and referendums in municipalities (chapter E-2.2 or the Election Act (chapter E-3.3)

is a qualified elector.



Any parent having a child who graduated after June 2007 will be registered on the list of electors for the Anglophone board.

However, if you have a child who graduated before June 2007, you will have, by default, been placed on the list of electors for the Francophone School Board.
