COMMON REQUIREMENTS

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- A Teacher who acts in the capacity of vice-principal in a school where the number of students does not warrant the appointment of a vice-principal.
- On-call to replace the principal when he/she is not available. From time to time and the principal's discretion, this might necessitate being substituted from classroom teaching.
- Stand-in for the principal at lunch hour by dealing with discipline issues and other matters that arise during that time.
- Leadership in special project/assignments throughout the year beneficial to the school.
