### NATURE OF THE WORK

In general, the employee works according to instructions or under the supervision of a caretaker, night caretaker, foreman, maintenance workman, class I or a qualified workman. In addition, he or she may be required to perform the characteristic functions of the class of employment of maintenance workman, class III.
